Rules and Regulations

1. The competition is open to all residents of the State of Florida, **18 years of age or older unless authorized by Mai Tai Bar Management**, GUESTS OF THE MAI TAI BAR MUST BE 21 YEARS or OLDER after 9pm.

2. Any Grand Prize Winners of a previous Mai Tai Rumble are not eligible to enter the 2019 Mai Tai Rumble competition, unless an individual performer is with another duo or group.

3. Each entrant must complete a packet of information that includes:

A) sound & stage requirements;

B) stage layout;

C) bio information;

D) waiver / entry form.

E) W9 – Tax form

F) Picture of band for promo purposes

All information must be complete and accurate. Incomplete packets will not be considered for entry into the 2018 Mai Tai Rumble.

4. If chosen, groups or soloists will be scheduled as the Mai Tai Bar sees fit. Special days and times may not be granted but will be highly considered. You will be contacted by phone for date. All participants will be required to show up prior to the start of the competition. Times and dates will be chosen by us. You will **only need to be available one of the Thursdays and then the Finals** if you win your week. Remember if your application is incomplete, you will not be contacted.

5. All members of the group **must check in** with the event coordinator at least **60 minutes prior** to scheduled performance time. **Cancellations for scheduled performances** must be made at least **48 hours** prior to **Tina Delorme - GM – (386) 947-2493(W) or 386-679-4064(C)** for any rescheduling consideration. “No shows” will be disqualified from the event.

6. The following backline equipment will be provided: 1 bass amp; 1 guitar amp; complete drum set including stool, snare and pedal, (no cymbals). Any questions pertaining to equipment can be addressed by contacting **Ben Gardner (321) 202-0011**.

7. A complete sound system will be provided. All effects and monitor levels will be pre-set at the discretion of the Mai Tai Bar technician. Managers, technicians and band members may not request level changes. **Only Band members** will be allowed near or on the stage. Stools or chairs will be allowed on stage but must be pre- prearranged.

8. All musical equipment must be prepped and tuned outside, little time will be allowed on stage. Acoustic instruments must be plugged in to the sound system for amplification. Each act will be expected to set up in 15 minutes and breakdown immediately after performance, no encores. You will be allowed any 4 songs that can be performed in 20 minutes. Should any performance run beyond the allotted time, points will be deducted from the final score.
9. All live performances containing excessive profanity, indecent gestures or behavior will be terminated immediately. The leader will be held responsible for the behavior of each individual in his or her group.
10. The consumption of alcoholic beverages prior and during performance is allowed but in moderation. No Alcohol on stage. Any acts of over intoxication will result in disqualification and asked to leave the competition and premises.
11. Each entrant shall be properly attired for the live performance at The Mai Tai Bar. Shirts & Shoes are required due to safety regulations.
12. Each week a total of 6 acts, 3 cover & 3 original will perform Thursdays at the Mai Tai Bar for 3 weeks. A winner will be chosen each night from each category to perform in the finals. You only have to be available for one
13. All band entries will receive a cash prize just for participating in the preliminaries. In addition, prizes at the Finals will be awarded to the winner and everyone participating in each category. There will also be one additional band in each category who will have the chance to be voted into the finals via Facebook with a wild card vote. Additional prizes may also be awarded in both the preliminary events and the finals.
14. All contestants, by entering the contest, are agreeing to performances in connection with the Mai Tai Rumble as requested by the Mai Tai Bar, including initial performance and finals.
15. The Mai Tai Bar and sponsors assume no responsibility for loss or damage to any equipment or personal effects of groups entering the 2019 Mai Tai Rumble. We will have security stationed at the tent to help watch equipment as equipment can not be in the bar.
16. All decisions of the judges shall be final and binding.

As a representative of the group:

A). I hereby grant permission to film, videotape or record in any form, our performance and activities in association with the Mai Tai Rumble.

B). I hereby grant the Mai Tai Bar full and free right and permission to use, reuse, copyright, broadcast and/or republish videotape recordings, interviews, and/or photographs of my group and our material in any form, including the use of any printed matter in conjunction therewith. I understand that these may be used for promotional, news, research and/or educational purposes and may be published in any form, including on the internet.

I certify that I have authority to do so and that my signature binds the entering band and its performers to all elements of this contract. 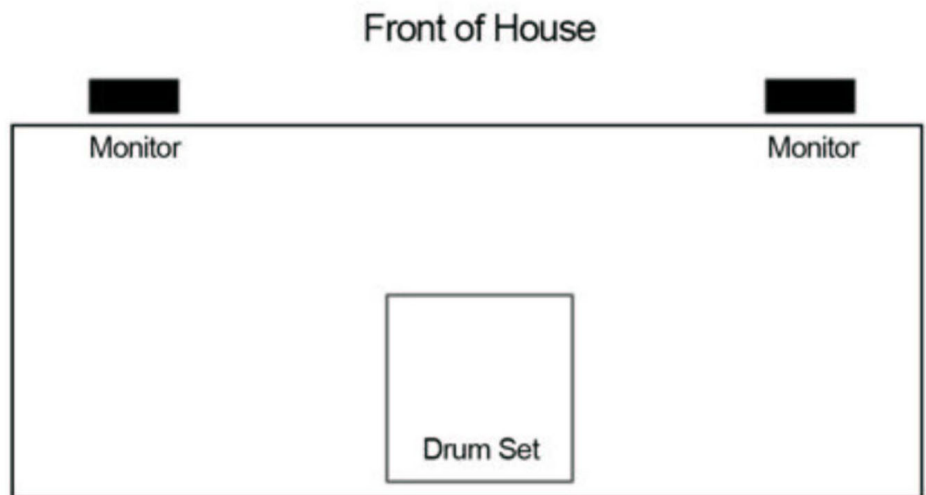
